Knee replacement surgery involves removing damaged bone and cartilage from the thighbone, shinbone, and kneecap. The procedure is then followed with placing an artificial joint or prosthesis that is made of metal alloys, high-grade plastics, and polymers.

Your orthopaedic first examines your knee's condition by looking at x-rays among others before determining if a surgery was needed. Surgical techniques and prostheses may vary depending on your age, knee size and shape, and health condition.

Generally, those who need a total knee replacement are those with severe knee pain – more often than not caused by osteoarthritis.

- 4 Days 3 Nights Ward (2 Bedded) + Meals (additional 1 day high dependency unit care for replacement of both knees)
- Pre-surgery blood tests
- Surgeon, anaesthetist and nursing fee included

- Physiotherapy x 8 sessions (additional 2 sessions for replacement of both knees)
