(Observation)

Malaysian Citizens:

- RM2500 for up to 2 weeks placement.
- RM5000 for up to 4 weeks placement.

Non-Malaysian Citizens:

- RM5000 for up to 2 weeks placement.
- RM10,000 for up to 4 weeks placement.

Additional Considerations:

Application Fees: There will be an administrative fee of RM500 to process the application. Specialty: Premium or highly specialized programs may have higher tuition fees.

Selection Process

Application can be made by sending the following documents to *fellowship@ucsihospital.com*.

- · Cover letter
- · Curriculum vitae
- Copy of National identity card / Copy of Passport
- · Certified Copies of Bachelor's Degree
- Certified Copies of Postgraduate Training
- Copy of valid practicing certificate from medical council / Copy of Certificate of Good Standing
- Letter of recommendation from two referees
- 1. Eligible candidates will be selected by the Postgraduate Training Committee within 30 days of application and will have to undergo a pre-assessment/interview..
